Study Permit

What you Need to Do



Submit **Biometrics** and **Medical Exams**

Students must apply for their initial study permit from outside of Canada and it must be approved before they come to Canada.

Prepare your application

- Make a checklist on all the documents that are required
- Gather your required documents
- Complete the Application Form

Apply for a Study Permit (Application Fee is \$150 CAD ~ Rp 1,750,000) – 3 Methods of Applying:

- [Online through the Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada \(IRCC\) site \(Recommended\)](#)
- Or through In person at a Visa Application Centre (VAC)
- Or By mail to the appropriate visa office
- Download the paper application in the "Apply on paper" section of the IRCC website

Study Permit

What you Need to Do (After Applying)



1. Submit Biometrics and Medical Exams

Biometrics – fee of **\$85 CAD ~ Rp 990,000** will be required at the time of application:

- Submit your biometrics (fingerprints and photo) in-person at the nearest biometrics collection point.
- Some students may need to travel within their home country or in some cases, apply for a visa to travel to another country to submit biometrics.
- Biometrics are still valid for use for up to 10 years.

Medical Check-Up Exams

- Normally, new students are required to do Medical Check-Up Exams.
- Usually in Jakarta, students are referred to RS Premier Bintaro for MCU
- Fees are approximately Rp 1,800,000.
- In general, submitting an upfront medical exam, or e-medical, reduces delays in application processing.

What you Need to Do (After Applying)



2. If your study permit application is approved

You will be issued a Letter of Introduction.

You will need to present this letter to the Canada Border Services Officer when you arrive in Canada to have your study permit issued on the spot.

Study Permit

What you Need to Do (After Approval)



Get your TRV/eTA (if applicable)

- After your study permit has been approved, you will automatically be issued one of these documents to travel to Canada:
- Temporary Resident Visa (TRV), or
- Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA)
- If you are from a TRV-required country, you will need to submit your passport to have your TRV (also known as a 'visa') inserted.
- Usually for Indonesians, this means you would have to submit your passport to the VFS (Visa Facilitation Services) in Indonesia and retrieve it once you've been approved.

Arriving in Canada and presenting your Letter of Introduction

- Present your Letter of Introduction to the Canada Border Services Officer at the first place you arrive in Canada and request a study permit
- Submit the ORIGINAL Letter of Introduction, NOT scans or photocopies, bring all the original documents that you have that are required
- Before leaving the officer's desk, ensure the information on your study permit is correct and that it states you 'may work' or 'may accept employment.'

3rd Party Agents (such as InterLink, SUN Education, etc) are also very equipped in helping you apply for your Visa and Study Permit, or to answer any questions regarding other additional requirements (Biometrics, MCU, for example).

Duration:

- Approximately takes 1-2 months to process
- Encouraged to apply/extend in advance to provide enough time for its completion
- Processing times are delayed due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, please advise to complete applications by the correct deadlines in order to avoid receiving late approvals.

Study Permit

Important Things to Note



For Indonesians, Study Permit and Student Visa though related, are separate documents.

- You receive your official Study Permit document after your arrival in Canada.
- You receive your Student Visa once you retrieve your passport back from the VFS (after it's been approved), before departing to Canada.

For both Student Visa and Study Permit, it follows the duration of your Program of Study that is written on the Letter of Acceptance, and/or your Passport.

For example, you're expected to graduate by 2025, so your Study Permit and Student Visa will expire by then (+ 90 days).

If your passport expires earlier than your intended graduation, both Visa and Permit will follow the expiration date of the passport. If your passport won't expire anytime soon, both Visa and Permit will follow the duration of your Program of Study, as stated earlier.

So, even if your expected end of study is 2025, if your passport expires beforehand, your Visa and Permit will automatically follow that date first. And vice versa, if your Study Permit expires beforehand, your Visa and Permit will follow that.

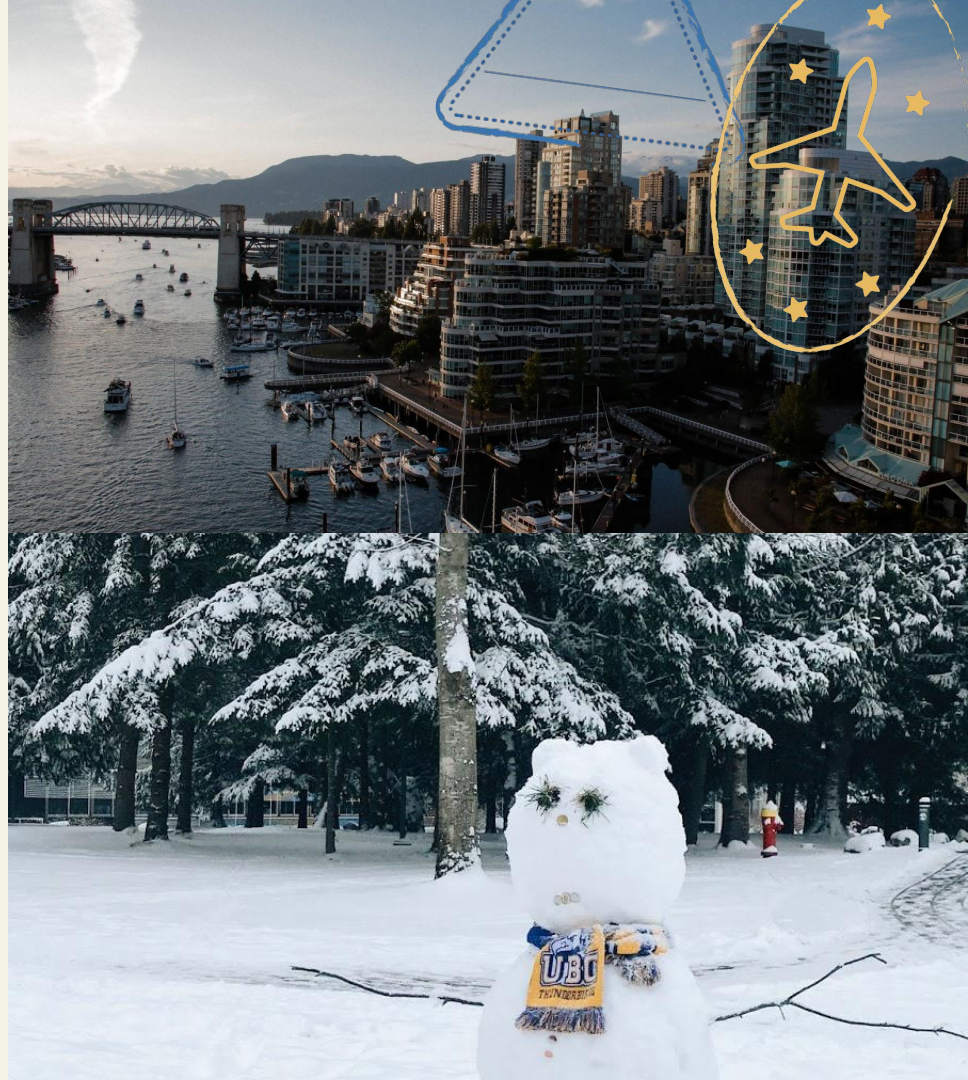

Who can come to Canada?

International students: Travel restrictions and exemptions



Study permit

To be able to enter Canada as a student, you must meet 2 requirements:

1. You must have a **valid study permit or a letter of introduction** that shows you were approved for a study permit
2. You **must be attending a designated learning institution (DLI) with a COVID-19 readiness plan approved by its province or territory**

You can only enter Canada if you have all of the required documents and your DLI is on the approved list.

Who can come to Canada

International students: Travel restrictions and exemptions

To be able to enter Canada as a student, you must meet 2 requirements:

1. You must have a **valid study permit or a letter of introduction** that shows you were approved for a study permit
2. You **must be attending a designated learning institution (DLI) with a COVID-19 readiness plan approved by its province or territory**

You can only enter Canada if you have all of the required documents and your DLI is on the approved list.

As a student, you **will not be allowed** to enter Canada if:

- your study program has been cancelled or suspended
- you're entering Canada for any reason other than to study

Find out if you can travel to Canada – Foreign national without symptoms – Non-U.S. – Student:

You will **likely be allowed** to enter Canada if you meet these requirements; however, the final determination will be made by a government official at the port of entry.

Planning your **entry** to Canada

International students: Requirements/What to Do Next

- Check that your school is a designated learning institution (DLI) with a COVID-19 readiness plan
 - a. bring your **valid study permit** (or proof of the approval)
 - b. make sure that your **medical exam has not expired**
 - c. bring a **valid letter of acceptance from a designated learning institution (DLI)** on the approved list
 - d. bring **proof that you have enough money to support yourself and any family members who come with you to Canada**
- You must meet testing and quarantine requirements. Use the checklist for your method of entry:
 - a. Flying to Canada requirements checklist

More Information on **Hotels**

1. You **must ensure** that you have a **confirmed booking at a government-authorized hotel before boarding a flight coming to Canada**.
 - a. Book your hotel in the same city as the airport of your initial arrival into Canada.
2. Border measures can change with little or no warning. It's **strongly suggested** that you **book your hotel as close as possible to your arrival date** in Canada.
 - a. If rooms aren't available for your preferred dates, must change your flight for when a government-authorized hotel is available.
3. Sharing a hotel room
 - a. **Only people who live in the same household may stay in the same hotel room** if travelling together.
4. You could face a **fine of up to \$5,000** if you don't provide evidence of a **pre-booked and pre-paid accommodation at a government-authorized hotel prior to entering Canada**.

More Information on **Hotels**

1. You can **only book** your mandatory hotel stopover:
 - a. **directly** with one of hotels listed
 - b. **by calling the central booking line**
2. You can book a government-authorized hotel for someone other than yourself. Contact the hotel directly to book.
3. **Reservations made through other travel agencies, online booking sites or apps will not be accepted.** If you book through an online travel agency or app, **you may be subject to a \$5,000 fine for not having the appropriate booking.**
4. If you prefer, you can also reserve and pay for your mandatory 3-night hotel stopover through the central booking line at GB Travel Canada Inc.:
 - a. 1-613-830-2992 (collect outside of North America)
 - b. Hours of operation: 8 am to 11 pm ET, 7 days a week
5. **Get a confirmation** from the hotel to **show at the border**
6. **Print your confirmation** or **have the email or a screenshot** ready to show to a government official at the border.
7. Your hotel booking confirmation email will include an alphanumeric trip reference code that will be used as your booking reference number when you enter your trip information into ArriveCAN.

1. Part-time dan Full time
 - a. Saat sedang kuliah, hanya boleh bekerja part-time dengan restrictions: 20 hrs/week
 - b. Saat summer dan tidak mengambil kelas, bisa bekerja full time (>20 hrs/week)
2. Co-Op
 - a. Tergantung universities
3. Internship

1. Fungsi PGWP:
 - a. Pengalaman kerja di Kanada
 - b. Membantu resume untuk apply PR (Permanent Resident)

 - a. Tergantung oleh waktu sekolah
3. Kapan apply:
 - a. Setelah lulus

APPENDIX

Fully Vaccinated Traveller Exemption Checklist

Starting July 5, 2021, **fully vaccinated travellers who are permitted to enter Canada may be exempted** from the federal requirements to:

- **quarantine**, including the government-authorized hotel for air travellers, and
- **complete a day-8 test**

Final determination regarding this exemption is made by a government representative at the border based on the information presented at the time of entry into Canada.

Travellers who crossed the border **before** July 5, 2021 **do not qualify for the exemption**.

Before you arrive:

- ☐ Find out if you can enter Canada
- ☐ Check if you qualify for fully vaccinated exemption
- ☐ Get your pre-entry COVID-19 test
- ☐ Register in advance for your arrival test
- ☐ Have a quarantine plan in case you don't receive the exemption
- ☐ Use ArriveCAN to submit your proof of vaccination

Fully Vaccinated Traveller Exemption Checklist

Arriving in Canada (Have the following items with you for assessment by a government official at the border):

- ☐ ArriveCAN receipt
- ☐ proof of vaccination
- ☐ pre-entry test results
- ☐ other travel documents

After you arrive:

- ☐ Take a test on arrival or get a home test kit (as instructed)

If you meet the requirements and are exempt from quarantine, you may travel on by air or land to your destination.

You must:

- follow local public health measures and wear a mask while in public for 14 days
- maintain a list of all close contacts for your first 14 days in Canada
- keep copies of your proof of vaccination for 14 days

Flying checklist (if **not eligible for fully vaccinated** traveller exemption)

Before you arrive:

- ☐ Find out if you can enter Canada
- ☐ Assess your quarantine plan before you travel
- ☐ Get your pre-entry COVID-19 test
- ☐ Reserve your 3 night hotel stopover
- ☐ Register in advance for your arrival test
- ☐ Use ArriveCAN to submit your travel and quarantine plans

Boarding your flight:

- ☐ Have your pre-entry test results ready to provide to the airline
- ☐ Check the requirements for boarding a flight to Canada

*Vancouver International Airport is open for International Flights' arrival and departure.

Flying checklist (if **not eligible for fully vaccinated** traveller exemption)

Arriving in Canada:

- ☐ Have your ArriveCAN receipt, test results, hotel confirmation and quarantine plans ready for assessment by a Border Services Officer
- ☐ Take a test on arrival
- ☐ Go directly to your pre-booked hotel for up to 3 nights to await results from your arrival test

Completing your hotel stopover:

The timing of your departure from the hotel to the place you will complete the rest of your quarantine period depends on the results of your arrival test.

- ☐ Who has to do a hotel stopover and list of hotels
- ☐ Await test results at the hotel

Flying checklist (if **not eligible for fully vaccinated** traveller exemption)

Completing your full quarantine:

On day 8 of your quarantine, you will take another test, following the instructions provided to you. You must stay in your place of quarantine while you await the results from this test.

- ☐ How to travel to your place of quarantine
- ☐ How to quarantine after the hotel
- ☐ Use your Day-8 test and await results
